

**❖ Best Practice II - Competitive Exam Cell :****• Introduction :**

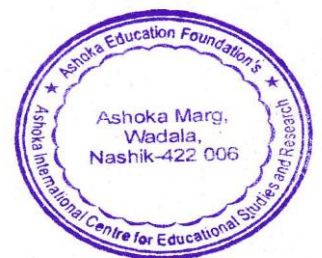
