INTRODUCTION

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year 1969, under the ministry of Youth Affairs And Sports Government of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary

focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity.

In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his students audience time and again was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The first duty of the student should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods and service so essential to society. Advising them to form living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do “something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level”.

NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as program aids.

OBJECTIVES OF NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving.
- Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
- Develop competence required for group – living and sharing responsibilities.
- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters.
- Practice national integration and social harmony.

DAY – 1: SUNDAY, 06.01.2019

The forenoon session of the Day began with a Procession by volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. The camp began with the inaugural function in the Moh Village.

The chief guest of ceremony Mr. Wasudeo Bhende Administrator AEF, Mr. Bodke Sarpanch Moha village and villagers with NSS program officer Prof. Savita Shinde, Prof. Ganesh Wagh, Prof. Priti Sonar I/C Principal of Ashoka International Center For Educational Studies And Research. The inaugural speech was delivered by dignitaries, emphasised the role of NSS in the Community service. Importance of cleanliness & use of water. Sarpanch of the Village and several village people attended the function. Village authorities welcomed the team of Volunteers into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a success. During the Afternoon of the First Day Volunteers interacted with Village people and visited the people in their houses discussed about their needs and Requirements and harms in the village. Volunteers created awareness through door to door Campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, importance of environment, cleanliness and agriculture.

Students visited Khandoba tekdi, for site visit for rain water harvesting technique to be used. Agriculture officer Mr. Sonawane guided students & decided to make continuous counter trenches CCT. After taking dinner volunteers discussed the project agenda and activities with NSS programme officer.

At evening, student's volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed dust heaps and attempted to create awareness on Cleanliness and hygiene.



In the morning all volunteers used to get up at 5.30 am sharp. Then at 6am we all use to start the exercise any prayer till 7am. After that volunteers used to make breakfast.

In the evening session Lecture was organised of Mr. Jayant Dixit, Director swami Vivekananda kendra on the topic of message of Vivekananda to today's youth. Students got highly motivated from thoughts of Vivekananda & understood the importance of tolerance & self control.

Day 04 ended with satisfaction of actual construction of CCT project through which they can percolate 75000 litres of rain water in earth.
